
**10 golden rules for
a successful installation**

① Test the devices

And your settings before installing the devices on site

② Vertical antennas

Radio antennas must be upright

③ Antennas at more than 30cm

For a better radio transmission, place antennas more than 30cm away from a wall or another Newsteo antenna.

④ Logger and key on the same channel

The data loggers and the radio key must be on the same radio channel to communicate.

⑤ Do not use channel 1

Change to another channel.

⑥ Monitoring mode

Use the "MONITORING" mode (except for specific conditions, watch video or check user guide)

⑦ Test the radio range

From your data loggers with RF Monitor before final positioning. (watch video or check the radio transmission guide)

⑧ Battery saving

Choose a measurement period > 1 min

⑨ Battery saving

Put the data loggers in Hibernate mode when they are not in use

⑩ Change the battery under 30%

When the Newsteo radio data loggers are launched for the first time, the battery level may be medium or low. After the normal period of chemical break-in, the level of the battery rises. In use, when the level goes below 30%, change the battery
